## WEEKLY PROGRESS UPDATE FOR JULY 3 - 9, 1998

# EPA REGION I ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER SDWA I-97-1019 MASSACHUSETTS MILITARY RESERVATION TRAINING RANGE AND IMPACT AREA

The following summary of progress is for the period from July 3 to July 9, 1998.

### 1. SUMMARY OF ACTIONS TAKEN

The monitoring wells located at MW-31 (300 feet downgradient of MW-19S) were developed. Well screens for MW-32 (3000 feet downgradient of MW-19S) were set at approximately 147-152, 162-172, and 182-187 feet below ground surface. The middle of these three screens is situated to intercept the maximum RDX concentration based on the USGS vertical particle track from MW-19S. Well development was initiated for the nest at MW-32. Drilling was completed to depth and monitoring well installations initiated at MW-33 located adjacent to MW-32. Additional copies of the Draft Completion of Work Report were shipped to EPA, MADEP, NGB, and the Review Team.

#### 2. SUMMARY OF DATA RECEIVED

No data from analysis of explosives were received or are pending at this time.

#### 4. SCHEDULED ACTIONS

Installation of monitoring wells at MW-33 will be completed. Development of newly installed wells at MW-32 and MW-33 will be completed.
